

## RULES &amp; REGULATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

1. He/ she has shown excellent academic performance with a CGPA grade of 7.5 or above in the semester.
2. He/she has not failed in any subject in the previous semester.
3. His/her overall attendance is not less than 80% in the previous semester. Grace attendance will not be considered.
4. The student should have completed all the academic requirements of the preceding year/ semester (whose academic merit is to be considered).
5. No adverse comments or disciplinary action shall not be reported in the Proctor office.
6. There is no case of indiscipline or non-compliance of FTII norms and policies as applicable to its students.
7. FTII scholarships are awarded from the Institute/ State / Central funds and therefore, should not be treated as matter of right.
8. Outstanding Institute dues, if any, may be deducted at the source and balance, if any, would be paid to the recipient.
9. FTII may decide to discontinue, partly or fully, FTII scholarships, sponsored scholarships/ awards/ honour at any moment of time, if it so desires and feels fit.
10. FTII scholarships are awarded from FTII fund for Indian nationals only and will be awarded strictly on the basis of 'SGPA Merit' to a Bonafide FTII student.
11. Regularity in attendance and exemplary conduct are expected of the scholarship holders. Misconduct or neglect of work in the class/studios or outside may result in the suspension or cancellation of the scholarship in part or whole, apart from any disciplinary action that may otherwise be taken against the scholarship holder.
12. No student can avail more than one scholarship/ assistantship/ freeship or remuneration from any other source during the same period except for scholarships sponsored by Centre, State. Student needs to submit an undertaking to this effect while submitting application form for the scholarship.
13. In the event of an awardee becoming eligible for another scholarship/ assistantship/ freeship or remuneration in due course from, FTII or any other source, the student will have the option to retain any one of the same according to his/ her choice. In such a case the student will communicate the choice in writing to the Registrar within one month of declaration of said additional

scholarship/ assistantship/ freeship or remuneration failing which FTII would have full authority to stop disbursement of the same. Further, in such cases if need arises, FTII may initiate process of recovery.

14. There may be instances where a student has compulsion on accepting the said additional scholarship or remuneration which might be lesser than FTII scholarship. In such a situation, the student would accept the same and would deposit matching amount to FTII which would further be awarded to the next person as per merit in the list of FTII scholarship. Students from categories other than general are exempted from this clause.
15. The scholarship shall at any time be liable to forfeiture if FTII is of the opinion that he/she has broken any of the conditions herein specified, seems if necessary, in the exercise of its discretion, to deprive him/her of the scholarship. Further, if any of the information submitted by the student is incorrect/ false or hiding the facts, FTII may initiate recovery procedure of its awarded scholarship apart from initiating disciplinary action in this regard.
16. In case any awardee leaves her/his course of study in between, no scholarship shall be paid to him/her.
17. All rules & regulations or parts thereof, amount & number of scholarship, awards, honour etc. are subject to change from time to time, as & when required, which will be binding on all concerned.
18. In addition to the primary requirements/ conditions as specified above, unless until specified by the sponsor/ State Govt. / Govt. Organizations, all rules & regulations as specified above for FTII scholarship would also be applicable to the sponsored scholarship, awards/ honour etc. Moreover, they may decide to discontinue, partly or fully, their scholarship(s), awards/ honour etc. at any moment of time, if they so desires and feels fit.
19. For any case which is not covered, the decision of Vice –Chancellor , FTII will be final and binding on all concerned.
