- 1. This order shall dispose of the appeal filed by Shri Kishor Digambar Kure in respect of ID No.77.
- 2. The appellant in his Original RTI application dated 31.07.2022 had sought following information under the Right to Information Act of 2005, (sub-section a (i), f, h, i, j, n, of section 2), (sub-section 1 (b) of section 4), (sub-section 1 (a), 3 (i) (ii) of section 6) (section 8, sub section 1 (j) of all information which cannot be denied to Parliament and the State Legislature.), (sub-sections 1,2 (a)(b)(c)(d)(e) of section 10) and (under sub-sections 1,2,3 of section 11.
 - 1. Photocopy of the resolution adopted by the Academic council of Film and Television Institute of India, Pune to implement the following clause (No. 14) in the General Rules / Instructions mentioned in the Prospectus of 2021. The copy of the resolution should be provided with the official seal, the signature of the head of the Academic council and the date of the resolution. (14) Minimum final cut-off marks to qualify for admission in FTII will be 50 % for General category, 45% for OBC (NCL) & Gen. EWS categories and 40 % for SC/ST and Gen.PWD candidates. Candidates with benchmark disabilities belonging to SC/ST/OBC_NCL/Gen.- EWS categories will be awarded benefits of the respective category as well as that of persons with benchmark disabilities separately i.e. qualifying marks to qualify for admission in FTII for General candidates with benchmark disabilities will be 40%. OBC-NCL & Gen EWS candidates with benchmark disabilities will be 36%& for SC/ST, candidate with benchmark disabilities will be 36% for SC/ST, candidate with benchmark disabilities will be 32%. (FTII PROSPECTUS OF 2021).



- 2. Please provide the date and year from which the following clause (no. 14) in the General Rules / Instructions mentioned in the Prospectus of 2021 is implemented by the institute in the admission process. clause 14 (FTII PROSPECTUS OF 2021)
- 3. Photocopy of the act/acts under which the Reservation policy is followed by the institute for the admission process to allocate seats to students of ST, SC and OBC.
- 4. All the above information should be given in a soft copy with written and stamp by email.
- 3. The CPIO/Dean (Films) sent a reply dated 25.08.2022
- 4. The Appellant has made the present appeal disputing on the reply given by the CPIO that the information provided by the CPIO is incomplete, misleading.
- 5. In view of the above the undersigned being the First Appellate Authority hereby regarding
 - (i) : upholds the decision of the PIO, as per the RTI Manual of FTII, information cannot be provided.
 - (ii) & (iii): Information has already been provided.

The appeal is therefore disposed of.
